- Fight Song with and without video (only needed if the band is not present)
- Institution Background Word Document
- Summary of the team's football history Word Document
- Five-minute highlight b-roll from the regular season with action shots*
- 30-second team intro video to be used during pre-game ceremonies*
- 30-second institutional spot for ESPN*
